



Announcement of the Eastern Economic Corridor Office

Subject: Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits in performing duties (No Gift Policy)

Fiscal Year 2026

The Eastern Economic Corridor Office (EECO) has emphasized on managing organization with good governance to build faith and confidence in the society that the EECO is a good governance organization. I, as the Secretary General of the EECO, hereby declare and demonstrate my intention to perform duties and administer national affairs at the utmost of my ability with accountability, honesty and transparency in accordance with the guideline that promotes ethical conducts, as well as adhere to the principle of good governance. I pledge that all EECO executives and officers have the intention of not accepting neither gifts nor profits in relation to performing our duties which would cause corruption and misconduct at the present and in the future. I would also stand against all forms of corruption to promote the value of honesty and integrity to build the organizational culture in strong and sustainable ways.

Therefore, in order to strengthen the core values of EECO executives and personnel and build awareness regarding their rights and duties in order to prevent all forms of corruption and inculcate the values of honesty in performing public duties. The EECO would like to declare itself to be an organization in which all officials under its supervision do not accept gifts and presents of any kind in performing their duties whereby all EECO executives and personnel understand and strictly abide by the following practices:

Clause 1 Do not request or agree to accept gifts and presents of any kind, whether before, during or after holding office or performing duties; whether related or not related to the performance of duties, unless it is given due to moral obligations or custom;

Clause 2 Do not offer gifts or presents of any kind in relation to the performance of one's duty, unless it is due to moral obligations or custom;

Clause 3 Do not consent to or connive with a family member or any other person to request or accept gifts and presents of any kind on your behalf, as well as refrain from offering gifts or presents in relation to the performance of one's duty;

/Clause 4 ...

Clause 4 Express your good wishes or gratitude by using greeting cards, blessing book, or blessing contents via social media;

Clause 5 In cases where it is unavoidable to receive or offer gifts of any kind due to a moral obligation or custom in order to congratulate, welcome, or maintain friendship or good relations, use of products supported by the government as gifts or presents are encouraged, provided that the price or value of gifts or presents must not exceed the amount specified by the National Anti-Corruption Commission or by law.
